

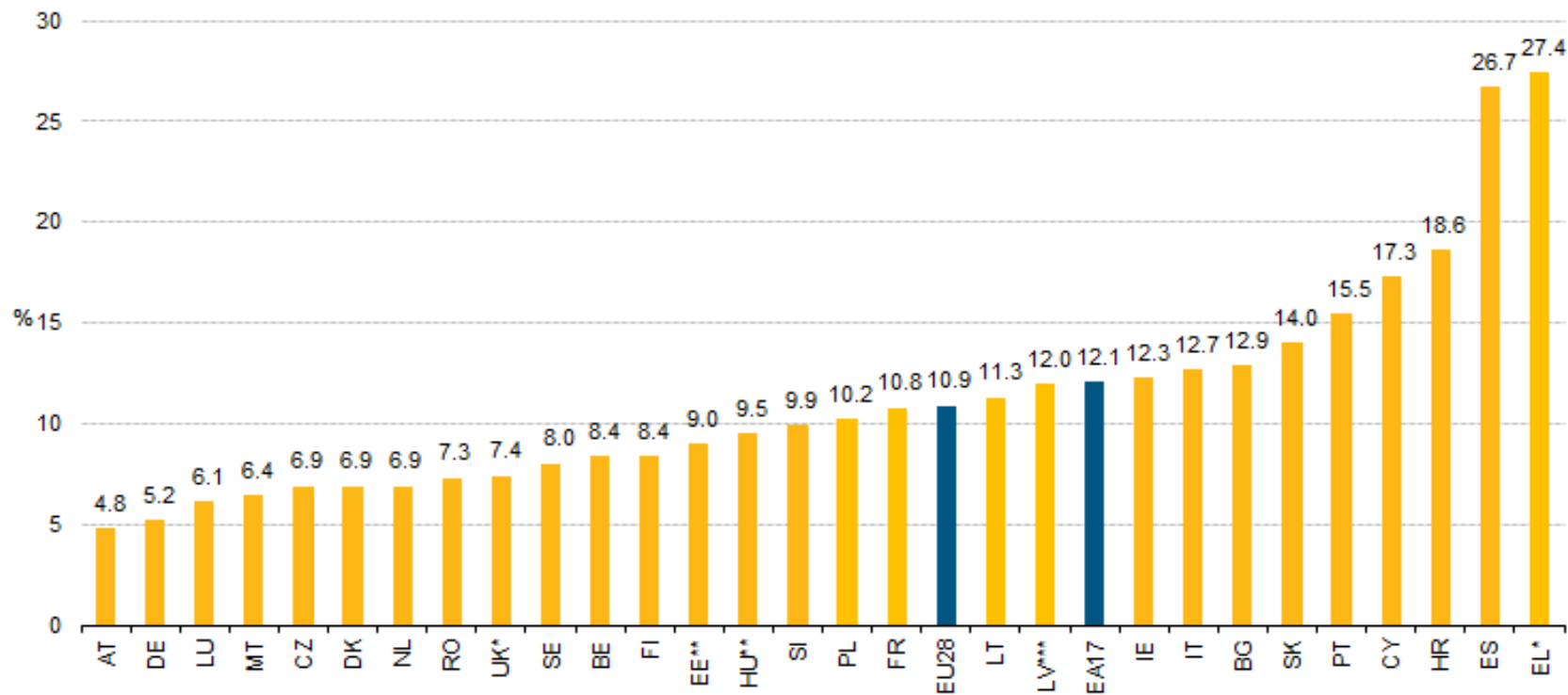

The highest unemployment rates:


- Greece 27.4%

The largest decreases:

- Ireland: 14.3% to 12.3%
- Latvia: 14.0% to 12.0%
- Lithuania: 13.0% to 11.3%
- Portugal: 17.0% to 15.5%
- Hungary: 11.0% to 9.5%

The highest increases:

- Cyprus: 13.3% to 17.3%;
 - Italy: 11.3% to 12.7%;
 - Greece: 26.0% to 27.4%
 - Netherlands: 5.6% to 6.9%

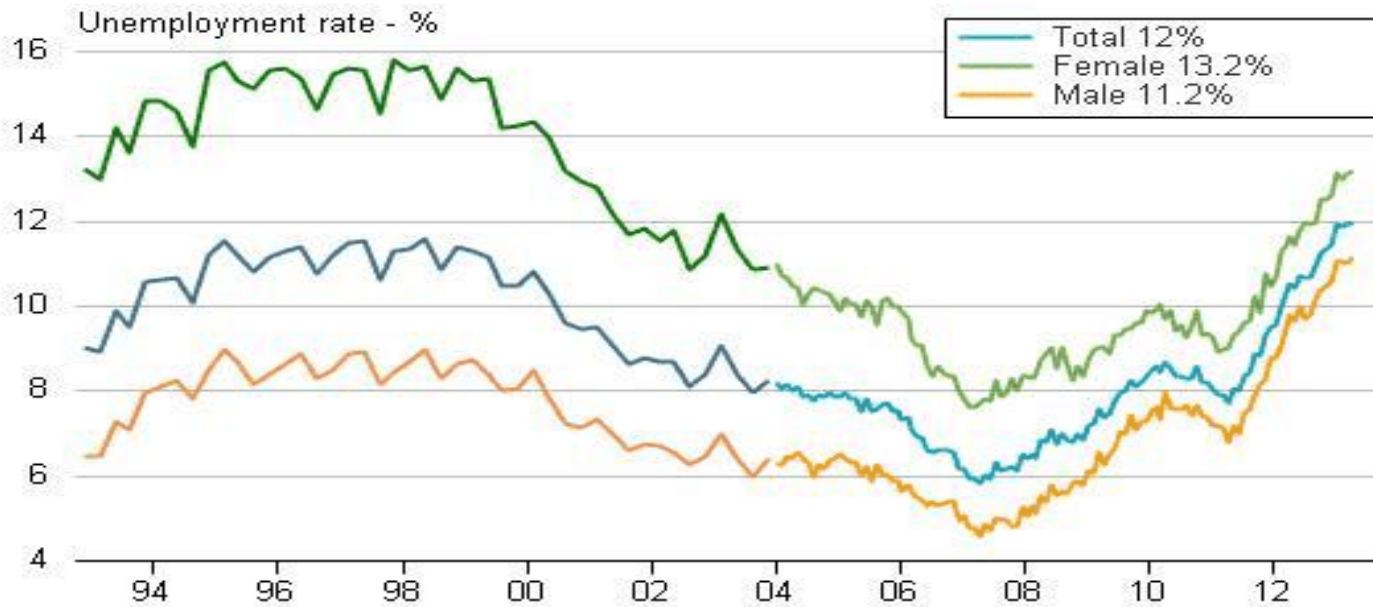

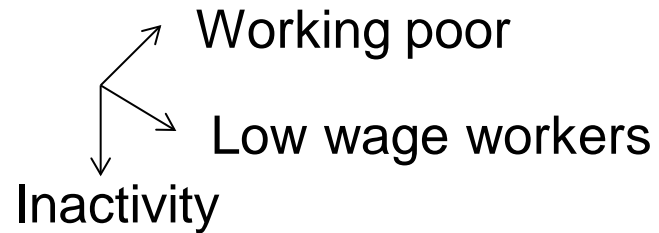

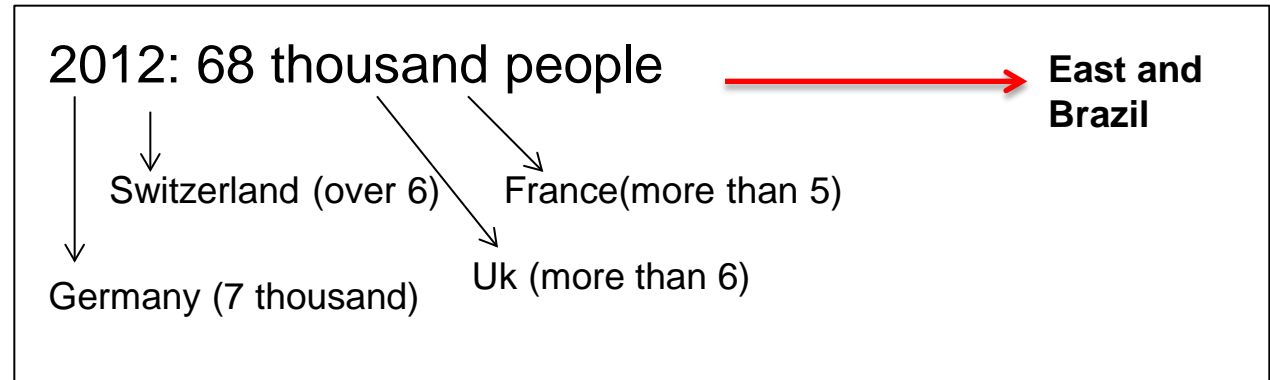


Many Unemployed young people



A return migration

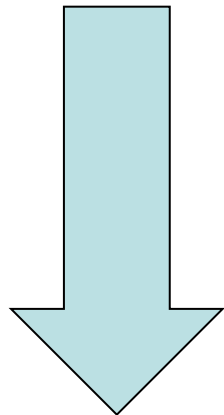

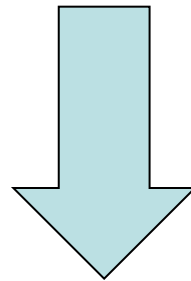

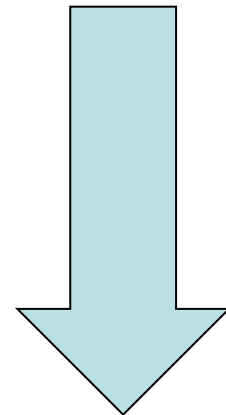
